





OIT Ad Hoc Committee

- A survey was distributed to inform planning of the symposium
 - 30 responses, ~40% response rate
- Each day of the symposium had 60+ participants, representing Canada, US, and Tribal nations
- An update on the symposium was provided to the LAW committee, and we are continuing to coordinate committee activities with them
- Presented BIOTIC draft results to ANSTF
- Next steps include finalizing a synthesis of the symposium and determining future activities such as industry engagement
